HEALTHY & SAFE WORKERS ARE ESSENTIAL

Employers also rank workplace safety as a high priority, understanding that healthy and safe workers are essential to a productive workplace. Employees in turn remain motivated if they feel safe at their workplace; thus, safety is a critical element of productivity for both worker and employer.



MAJOR FACTORS THAT CONTRIBUTE TO WORKPLACE INJURIES

- Working conditions with poor lighting or poor environmental hygiene
- Lack of protective elements such as missing guard rails on walkways
- Poorly maintained or misused equipment
- Unclear safety procedures or lack of safety training
- Unsafe walking surfaces
